As you know, every month, the Mission and Evangelism Ministry Team highlights an opportunity for the entire congregation to join in prayer for a particular mission of First Presbyterian Church. This March, we are praying for the France Mission Team. You have been able to read their bios in this newsletter. They will be serving and witnessing in July for several weeks, but we want to begin praying for them now.

Week 1 – Unity: Pray that the youth and leadership would unite as part of Christ’s body. That the bond of peace (described in Ephesians 4) would be theirs in Christ, our one Savior, our one Lord.


On Monday, February 17th the Session of First Presbyterian Church:





MAIN OBJECTIVES: Cut the grass for the first time of the year, weed eat, spray round-up, broadcast fire ant prevention, prune/shape shrubs, put six yards of mulch under children's play set area, level mounds of dirt behind columbarium and restack spare bricks, clean up brush from last year's work day.

THINGS THAT WILL ALREADY BE ON SITE: Church riding mower, church blower, church weed eater, fire ant prevention, two 5-Gallon water coolers, and 6 yards of mulch next to the playground area.

THINGS TO BRING: Gas Pruners, loppers, ladder, side walk edger, tine rake, leveling rake, pitch fork, flat shovel, mower, mower trailer, weed eater & string, blower, 50:1 fuel, oil, non-ethanol fuel, spreader, gloves, dust mask, safety glasses, wheel barrels, leaf bags, tarp, & all the young people you can find.

IF YOU DO NOT ENJOY YARDWORK: We need some volunteers to cook hot dogs and provide water/refreshments for the workers – Especially for around lunch time. Encouragement and support is definitely welcome.
